#### Provocation

I would suggest that the term as it is used in Reggio is to prompt a dialogue involving a collaboration which could occur both with and between a group of children, educators and families. In Reggio they rejoice in the possibility of dissonance providing differences in thoughts and ideas and the richness this provides for further thinking, theories, and possible strategies to further explore and research the provocation, both children and adults. - Examine beliefs, values, practices even 'sacred cows' and the 'taken-for-granted'
- Consider different perspectives
- Decide on action to improve practice
- Act
- Re-visit and critically reflect some more
